As part of our commitment to provide a world class service across Greater Manchester, this Household Waste Recycling Centre (HWRC) now accepts donations of unwanted household furniture for re-use. The new service is delivered in partnership with CT New to You.

If you are updating your furniture or thinking of having a spring clean then why not donate your unwanted items. All donated furniture at Lumns Lane is collected by CT New to You, a charity in Salford committed to supporting the community. By donating your furniture you will:

- help to reduce the amount of items that go to landfill
- help others in your local community

Check the list of accepted furniture (**see overleaf**) or speak to one of the site operatives to discuss donating your unwanted furniture.

### How does it work?

- Bring your unwanted items to site
- Speak to one of the site operatives to let them know you are donating
- Place your items in the Re-use Container

## What can be donated at Lumns Lane HWRC?

- Armchairs
- Bathroom Cabinets
- Bookshelves
- Rugs (rolled)
- Chairs (home or office)
- Chest of Drawers
- Cupboards (not kitchen)
- Display cabinets (home)
- Tables (wood or wicker)
- Filing cabinets (up to 4 drawers)
- Magazine racks
- Shelf unit
- Sideboard
- Sofa (2 or 3 seater) - must have fire safety tags
- Stools
- Wicker furniture
